

One Day Interdisciplinary National Seminar
**‘Silver Jubilee of Indian Economic Reforms (1991-2016) :
A Balance Sheet’**

The Department of Economics organized the One Day Interdisciplinary National Seminar on occasion of completion 25 Years of Indian Economic Reforms started in the year 1991. The seminar was held on 25th April, 2016.

Proceedings of the seminar was released at the hands of a well known scholar of foreign policy of India and Ex-MLA Maharashtra Vidhan Parishad Hon'ble Prof. Dr. Ashokrao Modak. Trustees of A.V.P sanstha Hon'ble Shri. Yashwant Vaidya and Hon'ble Shri. Pandharinah Baviskar were present for inaugural function.
