I.Q.A.C. (Report-2022-23)

The aim of IQAC is to maintain and enhance the quality of all aspects of the institution and overall development of our students. In the academic year of 2022-23, following various activities were conducted to fulfill the aim of quality enhancement.

❖ Organisation of Programmes

***Shiv Swarajya Din** was celebrated on 6/6/2023 to inculcate patriotic values among our students, Prof Ramesh Butere was the resource person for this event. He talked about various qualities of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and inspired students to accept and develop these qualities.

*Celebration of **Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav** was conducted from 9th to 17th August 2022, in which various competitions, cleanliness drive, lecture on local History, Singing of National Anthem, Say No To Plastic drive were organized successfully.

*International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21/6/2022, in association with Vivekanand Kendra Kanyakumari, Badlapur. I/C Principal Dr. Sangeeta Pande, explained importance of Yoga for health. Practical session of Yogasana was conducted. Ms. Meenatai Deshpande inspired students by guiding about health benefits of yogasana in life.

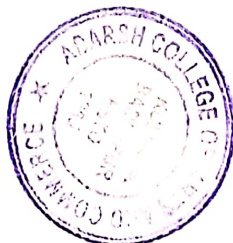
