M.A. PROGRAM

The University of Mumbai has introduced Credit Based Semester and Grading System for M.A. Part I program from the academic year 2012-2013. It will be applicable to M. A. Part II program from the academic year 2013-14. Following are the features of the Credit Based Semester and Grading System:

- 96 credits for entire Two Year Course (24 Credits per semester)
- 6 credits per paper (6*4 papers= 24 at each semester)
- Internal Assessment 40% marks. Term End Semester Exam-60% marks for each course in the program.

M.A. Part I (M.A. SEMESTER I AND II)

- ❖ ELIGIBILITY: A candidate for being eligible for admission to the course leading to the degree of Master of Arts must have passed the examination for the degree of Bachelor of Arts (three year integrated course) of this University or a degree of another University recognized as equivalent thereto.

- ❖ ELIGIBILITY: 1) Those who passed Semester I and II
- 2) A learner who has kept term in the First Year of Post Graduate Programmes (Under SBCGS) in Semester I & Semester II be made eligible to be admitted in Semester III (Second Year) irrespective of the number of courses appeared / passed in Semester I and Semester II.

However, the candidate is eligible to appear for Semester IV Examination only after passing Semester I and Semester II in full.

Results of Semester IV will be declared only after the learner passes Semester III in full. [Ref. Resolution passed in the meeting of The Board of Examination held on 5th August 2013. (AC 19/9/2013)]
